Fillipe was one of those individuals that wanted to make 120% sure this was the kit he wanted to build. He flew out from Texas to California for a weekend to check out the quality and immediately put ½ down, and flew back home. Thre weeks later the kit was ready for pickup.

The body kit was manufactured in 7 days by our team of Fiberglass experts.



These are the maestro's of the business. They make the body what it is, a work of art..

Once the body is complete, the construction and installation of the short range "Body Pallet" begins. This consists of (2) 2" X 4" studs, and (2) 2" X 3" X 77" boards.







The body is lifted on the trailer and the short range body pallet is inserted under the body and secured in 4 corners with screws and fender washers.







Next the individual parts are paper or bubble wrapped and mounted on the body pallet.







Back in Visalia, the short range body pallet is modified into the long range body pallet







There are now a total of (4) of the 2" X 3" X 77" boards going across. Front and rear support struts are added with 3 lag bolts on each strut to secure each. There is also a "protective bumper board" added on each side of the body.



The paper and bubble wrapped parts are secured inside of the body to the body pallet with ratchet tie downs.

While Fillipe was waiting for his purchase of the body kit, he was doing the modifying of his chassis to be used in the project.
