
I had to make 2 different throw away models to come up with 2 good ones. But, after A LOT of cutting of fiberglass parts from the inner door and the body shell. I got the AGP glass to fit, without having to cut the glass! Now I have to re-glass the pieces I cut for the needed extra space. The space is there. You just need to find and master it. Then it's easy from there! On these pictures, I am still missing the upper window trim. It's under construction. And the gap towards the mirror will be fixed when I cut it off and replace with an OEM replica mirror.











On these pictures...the window is down. I don't have the window regulator installed. So the window will actually go down about 1 more inch.



Here you can see the big gap on upper door glass area...that will be fixed when i put both pieces together. Sooooon! I am also thinking of doing the removable door skins done by Ron Tinari (YouTube.com - )
